DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Paint Additive: A small amount of Boiled Linseed Oil may be added to oil-based paint to improve flow, lessen brush drag, and increase both the gloss and durability of the dried paint. Follow the coating manufacturer's instructions for the addition of Boiled Linseed Oil. Do not use more than the recommended amount. **Furniture:** Boiled Linseed Oil can be used to develop the full warmth and richness of unfinished wood and increase its resistance to water-marks, scratches and warping. Rub Boiled Linseed Oil into the surface and allow 5 to 10 minutes to penetrate the wood. Remove excess oil with a clean, dry lint free rag. **Gunstocks:** Rub Boiled Linseed Oil into unfinished gunstocks to bring out their natural beauty and protect the wood. Remove any excess oil with a clean, dry cloth. **Other Uses:** Apply Boiled Linseed Oil to condition farm and garden implements and to help protect metal surfaces from rust.

HELPFUL TIPS: Boiled Linseed Oil must penetrate the surface of the wood in order to completely dry. Any excess oil remaining on the surface after application should be removed by wiping with a clean, dry lint free rag. An excessive buildup of Boiled Linseed Oil will cause a gummy residue or blotchy finish to form on the surface of the wood. **CLEAN-UP:** Clean tools and equipment with Mineral Spirits or Turpentine.

CAUTION! CAN CAUSE SPONTANEOUS COMBUSTION. EYE AND SKIN IRRITANT. Boiled Linseed Oil generates heat as it dries, which can cause the spontaneous combustion of materials contacted by this product. Oily rags, waste, and other oily materials contacted by Boiled Linseed Oil can cause spontaneous combustion fires if not handled properly.

USE EXTREME CAUTION. Immediately after use and before disposal or storage, you **MUST 1.** Handwash rags thoroughly with water and detergent outside in a bucket and rinse. Repeat washing and rinsing until you have removed all oil from all cloths, tools, rags, paper, clothing, mops and any other materials contacted during use or as a result of an accidental spill. **2.** Spread all rinsed materials outside to dry by flattening them out to their full size in an airy spot for at least 24 hours at temperatures above 40°F until completely dry. **CAUTION!** Contains Linseed Oil.

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED, call physician immediately. Call your Poison Control Center at 1-800-222-1222 or hospital emergency room for instructions. **IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT,** immediately flush with water, remove any contact lens, continue flushing with water for at least 15 minutes, then get immediate medical attention. **IN CASE OF SKIN CONTACT,** immediately wash with soap and water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

CONSEJOS ÚTILES: El Aceite de Linaza Hervido debe penetrar la superficie de la madera para que pueda secar completamente. Cualquier exceso de aceite después de la aplicación puede ser removido limpiando con un trapo limpio y seco. Una acumulación excesiva de aceite de linaza hervido puede causar un residuo pegajoso, o manchas de acabado que se forman en la superficie de la madera. **LIMPIEZA:** Limpie las herramientas y los equipos con destilado de petróleo o aguarrás.

PRECAUCION! PUEDE CAUSAR COMBUSTION ESPONTANEA. IRRITANTE DE LA PIEL Y LOS OJOS. El aceite de linaza hervido produce calor mientras se seca y puede causar combustión espontánea de materiales en contacto con este producto. Trapos, desechos y otros materiales impregnados de aceite en contacto con aceite de linaza hervido pueden causar incendios espontáneamente si no se manipulan correctamente.

TENGA MUCHA PRECAUCION. Inmediatamente después de usarlos y antes de desecharlos o guardarlos, **DEBE 1.** extender completamente todos los materiales impregnados de aceite para secarlos en un lugar con buena ventilación durante un mínimo de 24 horas a temperaturas superiores a los 40°F hasta que estén completamente secos; **2.** lávelos cuidadosamente con agua y detergente y enjuáguelos. Continúe lavando y enjuagando hasta que quite todo el aceite de los paños, herramientas, trapos, papel, ropa, trapeadores y cualquier otro material que haya estado en contacto durante su uso o por causa de un derrame accidental. Asegúrese de que toda el agua usada para lavar y enjuagar se elimine por el sumidero de drenaje. **¡CUIDADO!** Contiene Aceite de Linaza.

PRIMEROS AUXILIOS: EN CASO DE INGESTIÓN, llame al médico inmediatamente. Llame a su Centro de Control de Envenenamiento al 1-800-222-1222 o a la sala de emergencias del hospital para obtener instrucciones. **EN CASO DE CONTACTO CON LOS OJOS,** lávelos inmediatamente con agua y retire cualquier lente de contacto; continúe enjuagando durante por lo menos 15 minutos, después obtenga atención médica de inmediato.

EN CASO DE CONTACTO CON LA PIEL, lave inmediatamente con agua y jabón. Obtenga asistencia médica si persiste la irritación.
